

Do's and Don'ts for Visitors at Raj Bhavan, Itanagar.

Dos:

Dress appropriately: Wear modest and formal attire. Avoid casual clothing.

Follow security protocols: Cooperate with security personnel and follow security procedures, including any necessary identification checks.

Be punctual: Arrive at least 15 (fifteen) minutes before the scheduled time.

Respect the premises: Treat the surroundings with care and respect. Avoid touching or tampering with any artifacts or decorations.

Greet with courtesy: Greet the officials and staff with a polite and respectful demeanour. Use appropriate titles and forms of address.

Turn off electronic devices: Silence or turn Off your mobile phone and any other electronic devices before entering the premises.

Follow instructions: If you're part of a guided tour or event, follow the instructions given by the staff or guides.

Don'ts:

No unauthorized photography: Avoid taking photographs unless expressly permitted. Photography may be restricted in certain areas for security or privacy reasons.

No loud conversations: Maintain a quiet and respectful tone during conversations. Avoid loud or disruptive behaviour.

No wandering off: Stay within designated areas and follow prescribed routes. Avoid wandering into restricted or private areas without permission.

No Smoking or chewing gum: Smoking and chewing gum is prohibited on the premises. Respect no-smoking areas and dispose off any trash properly.

Don't bring large bags or backpacks: Large bags may be subject to security checks and could be restricted. Carry only essential items.

Avoid interrupting official proceedings: If there are official events or meetings taking place; avoid interrupting or disrupting them.

No plucking of flowers etc.: Plucking of flowers, fruits, tree leaves etc. is not permitted within Raj Bhavan premises.
